


## South West Region Newsletter

## Introduction

With a motorcycle test I then tell the candidate a couple of places that I would like them to ride to, I will have hopefully checked that this can be done by reading sign posts. I also suggest a place to stop normally a café of some type for the de brief.

I have over the years had complaints about examiners trying to use radios, or giving direction by the use of the examiners indicators. Also the way the examiner checks to see what



knowledge the candidate has on Roadcraft and the highway code. The examiner themselves should also ride correctly. Once again I would like to hear the different views in relation generally to the motorbike tests. In car tests it is a little easier for obvious reasons.
