ELECTION RULES:

- Only fully paid up members of RoSPA and SAPAR, including pillions and associates,
 - are eligible to vote
 - can nominate someone for the committee
 - can be nominated for the committee
- All officers and committee members retire annually. They can stand for re-election. This does NOT mean that they are automatically elected. Other people can be nominated for the same roles. If two or more people are nominated for the same role, the group members present and entitled to vote will choose one of them by vote.
- You can nominate yourself or someone else either
 - before the AGM (secretary@saparweb.com) or
 - at the AGM
- You cannot nominate someone who has not agreed to be nominated.
