14	AOB	<p>BMF advice, it was felt that this advice was sensible but their advice is not part of essential travel. Whilst this advice apparently comes from a group of organisations, of which the IAM is one, that promote advanced riding and post test training. It goes against the RoSPA and IAM stance of no tutoring/observing to take place.</p> <p>It was felt therefore that we should continue to follow RoSPA advice and put a hold on tutoring until end of lockdown. Rob had spoken with Stuart McMillan prior to this meeting and Stuart was of the same opinion.</p> <p>Ken to remove link from the website.</p> <p>Rob raised the question about membership and what people should pay, Rob is asking what data we hold on people and whether it is up to date and compliant with GDPR.</p> <p>We have had a complaint from Andrew Harrison who gets emails from Eliot Maslen almost every day, Ken is looking into it.</p> <p>We don't hold financial details or driving licence details. We only hold information we need to run the group and we do not hold data we don't need.</p> <p>The question still remains that we do not always know who has taken the tests if they don't tell us.</p> <p>We need to decide what we want to do with members whose tests are out of date.</p> <p>17 members with an out of date test.</p> <p>It was agreed that we are primarily a group promoting advanced motorcycling not a social group. If members do not wish retake the test then they are in the wrong group. However, if they wish to work towards retaking their test, then the group is happy to help with that.</p> <p>Agreed to send a message to members out of test to ask if they have a current test so we can make sure that our records are up to date</p>	<p>Rob to ask Tina to send this</p>
